

MEMBERSHIP:

D.O.V.I.A. is a professional association open to paid and unpaid managers of volunteers and those interested in the field of volunteer administration.

Membership can be either as an individual or at the organizational level. Organizational memberships allow for three representatives to attend meetings and provide a member discount on trainings for up to three representatives.

MEMBERSHIP DUES:

Free introductory membership through December 31, 2012. Beginning January 1, 2013, annual membership dues will be as follows:

- Agency Membership \$50 per year, up to 3 representatives from your agency.
- Individual Membership \$20 per year, a single representative.
- Student Membership \$10 per year, a single representative under age 22 enrolled in high school or college.
